The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The simplicity and tone of today's prelude reflect the mixture of despair and hope found in the Entrance antiphon: "If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord who could stand? But with you is found forgiveness, O God of Israel." Titled Imploration, it is from the pen of French pedagogue, organist, and composer Th odore Dubois (1837-1924). The postlude—Grand Ch eur, also by Th odore Dubois—reflects the other end of the spectrum: the joy and assuredness that is present in both the first reading and the psalm:

[referring to prudence and wisdom]: "Yet all good things together came to me in her company, and countless riches at her hands."

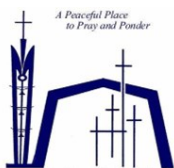

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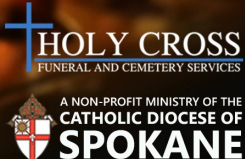
