### The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

*Christ loved us, and gave himself up for us, as a  
fragrant offering to God.*

This scripture, taken from Ephesians 5:2, is the Communion Antiphon for today, and provides the inspiration for the prelude music. Communion, by American composer Richard Purvis (1913-1994), seeks to create a prayerful and warm ambience with a deep thankfulness for Christ's holy sacrifice for our salvation, and for the sacrament of Communion which He has given us.

The Gregorian chant which is the cantus firmus for today's postlude—Gregorian Paraphrase on "Tu es sacerdos"—is based on the words from today's second reading: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedech." 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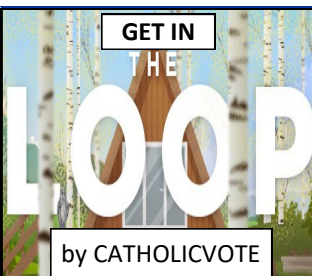
