Also known as Three Kings' Day - is a Christian feast day which is a special date for many Christians as it's when people celebrate how a star led the Magi - also known as the three kings or the Wise Men - to visit the baby Jesus after he had been born.

The 12 days symbolizes the time it took them to travel to baby Jesus and bring him gifts.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude music features two pieces: Prelude sur l' Introït de l' Épiphanie by Maurice Duruflé (1902-1986), and the fourth movement of Epiphania Domini, from L'Orgue Mystique, by Charles Tournemire (1870-1939). These two compositions share kinship in both inspiration and outlook. Both are based upon Gregorian chants from the liturgy for Epiphany, and Duruflé was a student of Tournemire. For the postlude—as with last week—the music is by German Baroque organist Johann Pachelbel (1653 -1706), who has used the Epiphany hymn *Wie schön leuchtet der Morgenstern* (How Brightly Shines the Morning Star) to compose a sparkling, lively rendition. End-of-Year Giving

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity ~ like St. Augustine Parish! QCDs can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distribution (RMDs) for the year, as long as certain rules are met. In addition to the benefits of giving to your charity of choice, a QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA, keeping your taxable income lower. Contact your financial planner and tax advisor about using a QCD to tithe to the parish. Thank you!

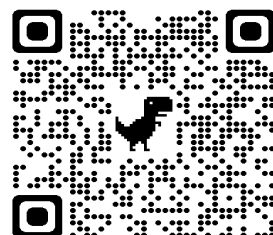
