#### The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude and postlude are both by twentieth-century French composer Louis Vierne (1870-1937). Legally blind from birth, he was the organist at the Cathedral of Notre-Dame in Paris, France, for thirty-seven years. Vierne was highly regarded as a composer and teacher, and had an international career as a concert organist. (In the early 1900s, he gave a concert here in Spokane on the pipe organ in the auditorium of Lewis and Clark High School!) The prelude, "Communion," is taken from his Messe basse (Low Mass), a set of meditative pieces to be played at masses with no choral singing. The postlude, "Carillon de Longpont," is taken from his Vingt-quatre Pièces en Style Libre and was inspired by the melody of the tolling bells heard in the village church of Longpont, France. It is a joyful postlude—a final alleluia, if you will-before the austere season of Lent begins, during which the organ will be much subdued.
