The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today is "Laetare Sunday," so-called because of the first word of the Entrance Antiphon "Laetare" (rejoice). Liturgical rubrics allow for the organ to break its Lenten "vow of silence," and thus the reason for today's prelude and postlude. The benediction, "Attende Lenten chant for Domine" (Hear us, O Lord, and have mercy upon us, for we have sinned against you) is paraphrased by French organist/composer Jeanne Demmessieux (1921 -1968) to create the beautiful and meditative prelude music. Although this prayer is not a part of today's liturgy, the sentiments match well those of today's readings. The postlude-Samuel Schiedt's Christus qui lux es et dies (Christ, who is Light and Day)—is based upon an ancient Lenten chant from the Divine office, the text of which is complementary to today's readings and Propers. If you would like to know more, please ask Joseph Schubert, the organist.
