

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Mother's Day is not a liturgical observance, but because the month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother, some of the preludes and postludes this month will have a Marian theme, such as today's prelude and postlude. The prelude, "Prière à Notre-Dame" ("Prayer to Our Lady") was composed by French organist Léon Boëllmann (1862-1897), and is the third piece in his famous Suite Gothique. The introspective melody that begins and ends the piece expresses a fervent and prayerful devotion, whereas the middle section expresses the urgency and angst that sometimes accompanies prayer. The postlude, by American organist Everett Titcomb (1884-1968), is his joyful Toccata, based on the Gregorian chant Salve Regina (Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy), the prayer that ends the Rosary.
