New Church Sound System

Rejoice! Our new sound system has been installed!

ListenWIFI is an innovative WIFI streaming solution that allows people to use their smartphones to access audio for assistive listening. Initial app installation and network connection is easy:

First, login to our WIFI network which is named "Sound System." For security purposes, you will need to pick up a copy of the user guide found in the church entrances in order to get the WIFI password. Second, install the ListenWIFI app which can be found in your Play Store. Third, connect your earphones. Fourth, launch the app. Lastly, choose an audio channel.

Tip: Hearing aids that connect to your phone should enable you to hear a ListenWIFI channel.

Thank you for your patience as we may need to make a couple of tweak here and there.

All parishioners should have received a mailing from Bishop Daly with information about this year's Seminarian Formation Appeal. It begins the weekend of June 14-15, 2025.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The text of the Entrance Hymn, "Holy, Holy, Holy! Lord, God Almighty," extols the attributes of our Triune God. The prelude takes that hymn tune and crafts from it a subtle and lovely meditation. Titled Nicea (which is the name of the hymn tune), it was composed by American composer and organist Calvin Hampton (1938-1984). The postlude is the third section of Johan Sebastian Bach's Triple Fugue in E-flat Major (BWX 552), the final piece in his monumental collection of chorale-based music known as Clavier-Übung III. This collection sets hymns that deal with Christian doctrine, and the doctrine of the Trinity permeates this volume via hymn text, scriptural allusion, and musical symbolism. If you would like to know more about these selections of the composers, please ask our organist, Joseph Schubert.


