The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

In past eras, the organ and choir played different roles than they do today in the chanting of the Mass Ordinaries (Kyrie, Gloria, Credo, Sanctus, Agnus Dei). Each of the Ordinary prayers was divided into sections, and the organ and choir would render them in alternatim—that is, the choir would chant a portion, the organ would play and a verset response. Therefore, there is a wealth of organ music based upon portions of chants from the Mass Ordinaries, and although we no longer use them in their original context, still they are appropriate for use elsewhere. Today's prelude and postlude are taken from that repertoire: the prelude is the sixth couplet from the "Gloria" of François Couperin's Messe pour les Paroisses (Mass for the Parishes), and the postlude is the "Plein Jeu" and "Fugue sur le trompette" from Messe pour les Couvents (Mass for Convents), Couperin (1668-1733) was a acclaimed French Baroque composer, and was organist at the Church of Saint Gervais in Paris.
