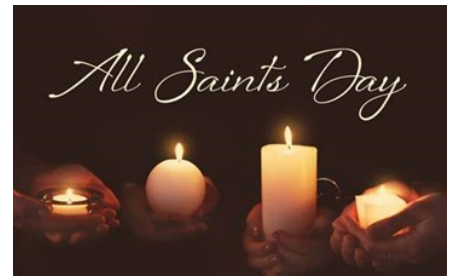

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude and postlude are both by Léon Boëllmann (1862-1897), French composer, critic, and organist of Église de St. Vincent de Paul, Paris. The prelude, the first of five *élévations* from his *Heures Mystiques*, Op.29, was chosen to reflect the first line from today's Epistle: "Beloved: I am already being poured out like a libation..." The tumultuous and ominous *Toccata*, from *Suite Gothique*, Op. 25, reaches its apotheosis in a sonic splendor that matches the last line of today's Epistle: "...I was rescued from the lion's mouth. The Lord will rescue me from every evil threat..." If you would like more information, please ask our organist, Joseph Schubert.

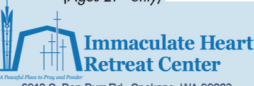
