The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude and postlude are both by Léon Boëllmann (1862-1897), French composer, critic, and organist of Église de St. Vincent de Paul, Paris. The prelude, the first of five élévations from his Heures Mystiques, Op.29, was chosen to reflect the first line from today's Epistle: "Beloved: I am already being poured out like a libation..." The tumultuous and ominous Toccata, from Suite Gothique, Op. 25, reaches its apotheosis in a sonic splendor that matches the last line of today's Epistle: "...I was rescued from the lion's mouth. The Lord will rescue me from every evil threat..." If you would like more information, please ask our organist, Joseph Schubert.




