FIRST FRIDAY HOLY HOUR

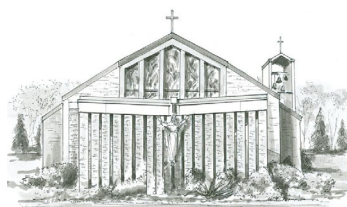

80TH ANNIVERSARY



The 80th anniversary of the founding of Corpus Christi Parish is July 26, 2022. Originally people from Scott and Greenfield Townships had to travel to Our Lady of Snows in Clarks Summit

for Mass. In 1940, twenty-six acres of land with an eight-room house were purchased from Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Kazmierski. Ground was broken for the construction of the original Corpus Christi Church on May 14, 1941 and Rev. Michael Polcha was appointed as the first pastor. The original church, now our catechetical center, was built attached to the farmhouse. The new church was dedicated by Bishop William Hafey and the parish was formally established on July 26, 1942

The parish grew over the years and on July 27, 1969 the current Corpus Christi Church was dedicated by Bishop McCormick.

Since that time, we all know Corpus Christi Parish was consolidated with St. Pius X establishing St. John Vianney Parish on September 19, 2009. While the parish name is St. John Vianney Parish, the Church building in Montdale is still known as Corpus Christi Church.

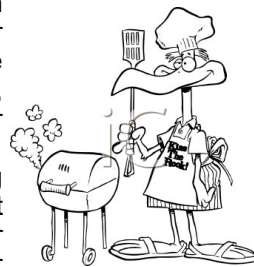
