



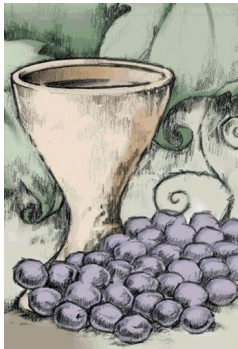

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is a reflective process through which individuals become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation: baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist.

OCIA is a beautiful journey of faith and conversion that involves informal learning about the Catholic Church's beliefs, practices, and life.

It includes not only those seeking to join the Church but also members of their parish communities, who are called to accompany them and who, it is hoped, experience a renewal of faith along with them. If you are not baptized, are baptized in another Christian tradition or are a baptized Catholic and seek full communion with the Catholic Church, consider OCIA for adults or children. It begins with inquiry sessions in which you can ask questions and discuss issues. The process continues with opportunities for learning and spiritual transformation. PARISH DEBT COLLECTION

Thank you to all who contributed to our second collection for parish debt two weeks ago. We collected \$1,538.00 for June.

Our parish currently has \$58,224 in past due bills. This is four monthly assessment bills from March, April, May and June from the Diocese (\$14,556 each month). While we paid three bills during this four month timeframe, they were for previously accrued bills.

So far we have collected \$4,685 in total from these second collections. This amount is less than one month's bill. If the regular collections are not enough to pay that month's bill, then that bill is added to our debt.

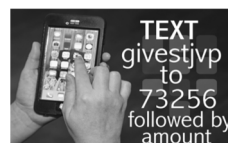
A second collection for parish debt will be taken up the second weekend of each month. It is hoped that we collect an average of at least \$2,000 extra each month so that we will be able to get caught up within two years.
