FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, April 18, by all Catholics over 18 years of age to the beginning of their 60th year. On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together should not equal another full meal, unless dispensed or excused.

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age or older. Ash Wednesday, all of the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstinence.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Stations of the Cross will be celebrated on Fridays during Lent at Corpus Christi. This ancient practice is one of the ritual ways the Church invites us to meditate on the passion of the Lord. The focus of this time of prayer is on the Cross. Please join us on Fridays during the Lenten Season for this time of prayer. Held on:

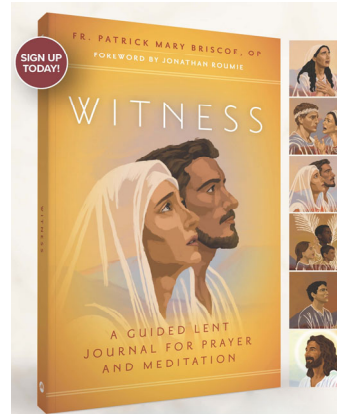

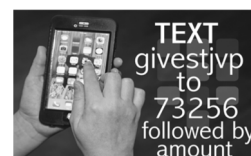
ARE YOU INTERESTED IN COMPLETING YOUR SACRAMENTS OR BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is a re-
flective process through which individuals become Catho-
lic and receive the sacraments of initiation: baptism, con-
firmation, and the Eucharist. OCIA is a beautiful journey
of faith and conversion that involves informal learning
about the Catholic Church's beliefs, practices, and life. It
includes not only those seeking to join the Church but al-
so members of their parish communities, who are called
to accompany them and who, it is hoped, experience a
renewal of faith along with them.

If you are not baptized, are baptized in another Christian
tradition or are a baptized Catholic and seek full commun-
ion with the Catholic Church, consider OCIA for adults or
children. It begins with inquiry sessions in which you can
ask questions and discuss issues. The process continues
with opportunities for learning and spiritual transformation.
