

Papal Itinerary Announced ~

The Vatican released the comprehensive itinerary for Pope Francis' journey to the United States, including his schedule for Philadelphia on September 26-27, which will close the 6-day Apostolic Journey.

Confirmed by the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and the World Meeting of Families - Philadelphia 2015, Pope Francis will take part in eight public events in the City of Brotherly Love and Sisterly Affection.

Note that registration is not required for the Papal Visit. The Holy Father is expected to participate in the Festival of Families, an intercultural celebration of family life around the world, which will be held on Saturday, September 26, and a Papal Mass celebrated on Sunday, September 27. Both of these events will be open to the public.

Saturday, September 26 Morning ~

The Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul: Mass celebrating the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

Afternoon ~

Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary: Greeting of the Holy Father by the Seminarians.

Independence Hall:_(Outdoor; Overlooking Independence Mall) "We Hold These Truths..." Address by Pope Francis (Expected Themes: Religious Liberty and Immigration).

Evening ~ The Benjamin Franklin Parkway: The Festival of Families.

Sunday, September 27 Morning ~

Saint Martin's Chapel at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary: Address to Cardinals and Bishops attending World Meeting of Families - Philadelphia 2015.

Curran-Fromhold Correctional Facility: Visit with prisoners and select families.

Afternoon ~

The Benjamin Franklin Parkway: The Papal Mass (Projected: 4 p.m. EST).

Evening ~

A Celebration of World Meeting of Families - Philadelphia 2015 Supporters and Volunteers.

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2015-16 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

If you are <u>new</u> to the parish or just moved into town and have not registered your children for **grades K-10**, please contact the Director of Religious Education, Annette Tracy at 973-543-5950, ext.13. The Registration Form is available on the parish website at: <u>www.stjoesmendham.org</u>.

Reminder to all families returning to Religious Ed ~ the DEADLINE for all paperwork was July 1.

Tuition ~ To operate the Religious Education program effectively and as a self-sustaining program, parents are asked to pay tuition. A schedule of tuition is set by the REFC Board.

\$200 Family Fee ~ Each family is asked to pay a Family Fee each year.

Additional Individual Fee ~ Grade K – 10 \$55 per child after July 2.

Sacramental Fee ~ Students enrolled in 2nd grade and 10th grade pay a \$50 Sacramental Fee in addition to the Family Fee and Individual Fee.

Catechist Discount ~ The Family Fee portion of the tuition (\$200) will be waived for parents who offer to teach a class. If two volunteers

share the teaching of a class, then each will receive a 50% discount (\$100).

During the month of AUGUST a letter will be mailed home with the final class schedule to each family enrolled in the program.
