of Families, which will be held on Saturday, September 26 at Independence Hall, and a Papal Mass celebrated on Sunday, September 27. at The Benjamin Franklin Parkway at 4:00 p.m

After significant review, evaluation and consultation with some pastors, the Bishop has decided that we will not sponsor, as a diocese, any trip to see the Pope. Some of the reasons are as follows:

1.5 million visitors are expected and 1.5 million residents already live and work in Philadelphia. Philadelphia has set up remote bus parking locations. Visitors would have to take a subway from the remote bus locations into Philadelphia to arrive near the Ben Franklin Parkway. There will be a 1 ½ - 2 ½ mile walk each way from the subway to where people will gather for both the Festival of Families and the Mass. The faithful will have to go through security. It is estimated that the trip by subway, walking and security check could take around 3 hours. The return to the diocesan bus would take even longer and keeping all the faithful together going to the Mass and returning to the bus lots would be difficult. Once at the bus lot, people will have to use a Smartphone app to find their particular bus, among the 5,000 other busses. There is no guarantee of getting close to the Sunday Papal Mass to see the Holy Father. There is no seating for the Mass and people will have to stand not only for the Mass but also the wait time for the start of the Mass. No chairs are permitted. The Diocese had to make this decision because they did not feel they could provide safe travel to this event and that the faithful would be able to achieve the fullest benefit from this spiritual event.

It is important to note that there is still availability for the faithful who wish to attend the World Meeting of Families that takes place Monday through Friday, September 21-25.
