



There is an annual Family Fee of \$200. The individual student fee structure is:

Grades K~10:

"Early" Registration rate:

\$30 per child if received on or by July 1, 2016

"Late" Registration rate:

\$55 per child if received on or after July 2, 2016

Additional Sacramental Fee:

\$50 per child in *Grade 2* only \$50 per child in *Grade 10* only

Your prompt registration is very important, as it will help us to address class size, day preference, teacher recruitment, discounts for textbooks, etc. You will be notified of your child's class placement and schedule in August. All classes are scheduled to begin in September.

Religious Education Program

Kindergarten is an optional program. On average, classes meet twice monthly, Sunday mornings **ONLY**, from 9:45~11:15 a.m.

CCD, Grades 1 ~ 6 meet on average twice monthly with sessions on Sunday from 9:45 ~11:15 a.m. or Monday, from 4:00 ~ 5:15 p.m.

Please choose the session that your children can attend in a timely fashion, (sessions that do not conflict with after school activities, sports, etc).

TLC, **Grades 7 ~ 8** meet on Monday evenings (on average twice monthly) from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m.

Confirmation, Grades 9 – 10:

The Confirmation program is a two year program, following 8 years of continuous religious education for students who attend public school.

Those attending Catholic High School need only to register for Year II in 10th grade.
