



Diocese of Paterson

New Jersey's Adoption Law has changed.

Beginning January 1, 2017, adoptees and certain relatives will be able to obtain a copy of their original birth certificate without a court order. The birth certificate will include the names of the birth parents who placed children for adoption unless a birth parent requests their name be omitted. Birth parents who wish to preserve their privacy must submit a *Redaction Request Form* to the New Jersey Department of Health no later than **December 31, 2016**. The *Redaction Request Form* can be obtained by calling 866-649-8726, ext. 582, or downloading it at http://nj.gov/health/forms/reg-36c.pdf.

Parishioners, please note: On our Diocesan website, <u>www.patersondiocese.org</u>, there is the Advance Directive for End of Life Issues available for printing. This directive has been approved by the Bishops of New Jersey.
