Register NOW for Summer/Fall Faith Formation Programs

It is now time to register for our Summer or Fall Faith Formation Programs. You may call the office at 424-4477 or go online to our website at www.olmnh.org to either download a registration form or you may also register and make your payment online.

Our Summer Program is for grades 1 through 5 and will run from July 16th through July 27th. Classes will meet from 9:30 to 11:45 am in the parish buildings. We offer 1 class per grade level and will take up to 15 students in each class. Make sure to register early to guarantee a spot in this program.
