We are happy to announce that this June we will be kicking off our brand new Sisterhood Sundays featuring the Lifeteen Unleashed program!

What is it?

Unleashed is a 6 session Bible study series on women in Scripture. We begin with the 10:30 Mass and resume in the church hall with a social activity (i.e ice cream, cook-offs, movies etc). We will then begin the session with scripture and conversation. Each session focuses on one woman in the bible and her story and how it relates to our lives. There is a fun DIY/take-home project included as well. The whole day is what we call a "Sisterhood Sunday"! This is for our rising 9th -12th grade girls!

Why Sisterhood Sundays and Unleashed?

Over this past year, we have heard the desire for a place where girls can get together and grow as sisters in the Faith. They expressed wanting to learn more about the women in our Catholic faith and their role in the Church along with wanting to read the bible more! They also expressed wanting to get together for fun events like mac and cheese cook offs and movie nights. We have tailored this program to be all that and more!

What is it?

Unleashed is a 6 session Bible study series on men in Scripture. It begins with the 10:30 Mass and resumes in the faith formation hall with the Unleashed session. The sessions begin with a dynamic game that ties into the life of one man in scripture. The boys will then read about the men in the bible finding ways in which they can relate to their lives. These sessions offer the boys a time to talk about their lives and learn about scripture while growing in brotherhood with one another. Open to rising 9th - 12th grade guys.

Why Brotherhood and Unleashed?

It is clear from seeing the boys attend Lifeteen throughout the year that they work well with one another and enjoy learning about the faith when it is presented in a dynamic way. Many boys have shared wanting to have more friends who share the same values and faith as they do. We see this as valuable and important and want to provide a space for these boys to grow in brotherhood with one another while learning about the lives of men in scripture who can serve as wonderful role models.
