September Confirmations!

Many of our youth were scheduled to receive Confirmation last April when our world was put on hold due to the pandemic. We are happy to announce that those Confirmations have been celebrated! Last year's 3rd graders who have been preparing for Confirmation and First Eucharist received the Sacraments on September 19th.
