# MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE

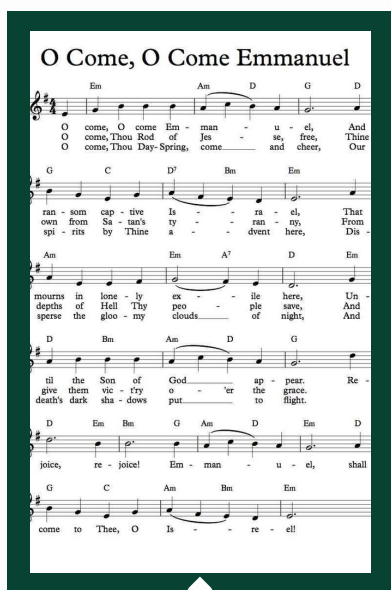

### Christmas Headbands Game

- Pile them face side down.
- Take turns holding them up to your forehead (so that you cannot see the card you are holding). Then ask yes or no questions until you are able to guess what is on the card. Ex. *Am I an object?*  
*Am I smaller than a kickball?*



## St. Nicholas, December 6

St. Nicholas of Myra, a bishop in Asia Minor who was nicknamed the Wonder-worker, was among the orthodox bishops at the Council of Nicaea who defended the divinity of Christ against the Arian heresy. According to one account, Nicholas, unable to bear Arui's blasphemous prattling any longer, walked up and decked him!

St. Nicholas was as gentle to the poor as he was ferocious to the wolves in sheep's clothing. He saved three sisters from prostitution by throwing bags of money through an open window or down the chimney of their house, enough to give them a dowry for marriage (and give us the seeds for his gradual transformation into Santa Claus).
