Statement from Bishop Donald J. Hying on the Death of Pope Francis

Madison – It is with deepest prayers and a profound trust in the mercy of Jesus Christ, that we mourn the death of Pope Francis. We remember Pope Francis for his evangelizing zeal, desire for peace in the world, and love for the poor.

How fitting that Pope Francis died during the Jubilee of Hope. In “Spes Non Confundit,” the Bull of Indiction for the Jubilee Year, Pope Francis wrote, “What, then, will become of us after death?
