Wow, what a great week, the highlight of the Church year.

This past Monday evening was the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral in Crookston where Bishop Hoepfner blessed the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens and then consecrated the Holy Chrism. All of the priests of the diocese renewed their vows during the Chrism Mass as well. One of my favorite parts of the Chrism Mass is when all the priests are gathered in the sanctuary and together they sing, "Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever." I always think that is so awesome hearing thirty or more priests singing this prayer together.

Thursday evening we celebrated the Mass of the Lord's Supper. At this Mass is when we celebrate Jesus instituting the Eucharist. We also received the oils that the Bishop blessed and consecrated at the Chrism Mass. We will use these oils here at St. Philip's for the next year, each and every time we baptize, confirm and anoint the sick. Also, at this Mass Father Don and Father Chuck washed the feet of twelve of our parish family, as Jesus washed the feet of his disciples.

Friday, was Good Friday, the only day of the year that Mass is not celebrated anywhere in the world. The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord was as always a very powerful and moving celebration for me. As Deacon, I have the opportunity to sing the Solemn Intercessions, praying for all people of the world. We also had the opportunity to adore the Holy Cross.

Then comes Saturday night, the Easter Vigil Mass, with all of its special moments. It begins with the lighting the new fire and the procession into the Church with the Paschal candle. It continues with the singing of the Easter Proclamation followed by the wonderful Scripture readings which proclaim the history of our faith, and is then followed by the Baptism and Confirmation of those entering into full communion with the Church. What a blessed way to celebrate the resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Congratulations to those who were baptized and/or confirmed and welcome to our St. Philip's family.

I hope you were able to participate fully in the celebrations of this Holy Week and if you missed any of them you will make plans to take part in them next year. We only have this opportunity once a year. Remember though, that Easter is not over after today. We have 50 days to celebrate the Easter season.

May all of you have a very blessed Easter Season!

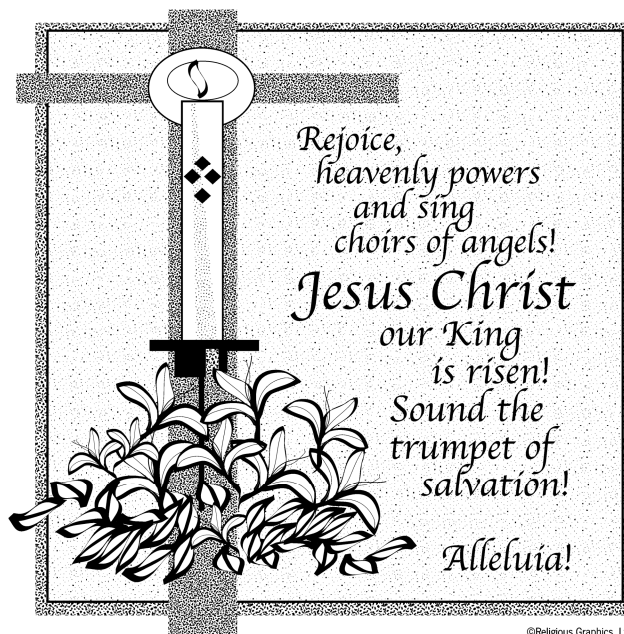

The Pastoral Council serves as a consultative body for the Pastor helping provide direction to the pastoral activity of the parish. Pastoral activity encompasses all the areas of the parish life especially the proclamation of the Word of God and catechetical formation, the celebration of the Eucharist, and other sacraments as well as the fostering of family and individual prayer, and serving those in spiritual or bodily need. 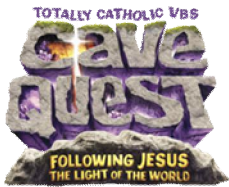

During the month of March, St. Philip's is joining people of good will from across the state to help alleviate hunger. Minnesota FoodShare's March Campaign is the largest food drive in the state, and congregations like ours are the heart of the campaign.

This year St. Philip's again will be collecting both food and cash contributions throughout the month of March for the Bemidji Area Food Shelf. Your cash donations will go further due to the ability to buy in bulk at a lesser rate. **Please make your checks out to the Bemidji Area Food Shelf**, and drop them off either in the Sunday collection or at the Parish Office. Donations of food may be brought to the church anytime during the month. Thank you for your generosity!

*Here are some facts on hunger:*

- For 34 years, Minnesota FoodShare has partnered with faith communities, schools, businesses and community groups to restock food shelves each March. In 2015, The March Campaign raised **\$8 million and 4.7 million pounds of food**, ensuring that thousands of Minnesotans were fed.
- There were more than **3 million visits to Minnesota food shelves** in 2013. Almost half of these visits were made by children and seniors.
- The Harvard School Breakfast Research Summary found that **lack of adequate nutrition can impair a child's ability to concentrate at school**. When kids eat a healthy breakfast there is an average increase of 17.5% on standardized math scores.
- **Children who experience hunger get sick more often**, recover from illness slower and are hospitalized more frequently than children who do not. Children who experience hunger are more likely to experience headaches, stomachaches, colds, ear infections and fatigue.
