Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In human history, there have been those who were well-known for their interest in all things related to death. Groups such as the Victorians built great tombs for their heroes and cherished their loved ones through the possession of personal items that once belonged to them, such as a lock of hair or a favorite photograph. For them, what was important was what was left behind, such as grandiose epitaphs that recalled for their heirs the great achievements of their deceased heroes.

As the end of another liturgical year draws near, the scriptures seem solemn and sober. We are challenged to consider our lives and to think about what our own remembrance will be ... what we will leave behind ... what others will say about us after we're gone. Will they say that we used our God-given talents well? That we did our part to improve that little part of the world where we lived? The study of this weekend's readings helps us to meet this challenge.

The Gospel tells us about three investors and encourages us to compare ourselves with them ... the two who took risks and gained, and the one who, because of his timidity and fear, made sure he did not lose the little he had. We might first think it best to side with the careful man, and why not? In today's world where anything can happen, it might be smart to be cautious, especially when it's with someone else's money.

But, we have to ask ourselves, is that what Jesus is asking of us? If we think of the word talent only as a huge amount of money, we might miss the meaning of this parable. Instead, we should see it as referring to something of tremendous value ... the Gospel message. Because Matthew has placed this parable before the Last Judgment, we know that it must be speaking to us about success, failure, and judgment. We know that Jesus calls upon his disciples to take risks ... to invest their whole lives in the truth of the Gospel and, if necessary, to risk everything for God's Glory.

If we can see the moral of this weekend's parable as encouragement to work diligently and boldly for the return of Christ, then now is the time for all Christians to wisely use and risk all their God-given gifts, talents, resources and faith, to share our Lord Jesus Christ with others, and to be the bearers of the fruits of that investment. For if we risk everything for our Lord Jesus Christ and the Gospel, we will be rewarded with His promise of eternal life ... and what we leave behind will be a path to salvation for others to follow.

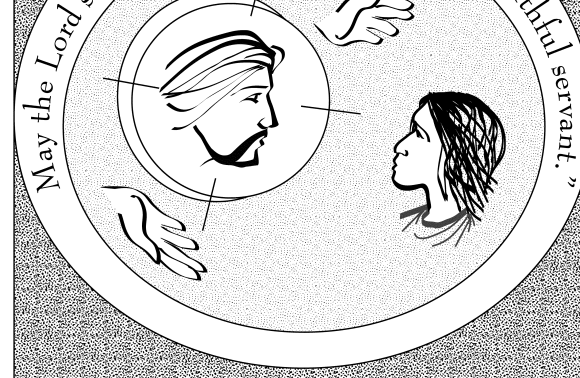

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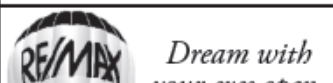


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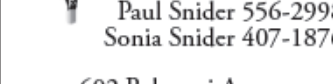
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
