## FIRST ALLEGIANCE

October 18, 2020

As we approach the November elections, we naturally reflect on our allegiance to our country. Yet, it is important to maintain our perspective: no allegiance is more important than our allegiance to God. Our primary identity is not as citizens of our country, but as children of God. It is God to whom we belong, first and foremost. This is the message we find in this weekend's readings.

This weekend's first reading from Isaiah is about Cyrus, the Persian king. God gave power to Cyrus so he could subdue the Babylonians. Cyrus then allowed the Israelites, who had been held captive for so many years, to return to Jerusalem. The rebellion that took place was not accomplished for Cyrus' sake or for his kingdom. It was accomplished for the glory of God. What was most important was that success did not belong to the Babylonians or to the Persians, but to God, and knowing that there is none other besides Him.

In this weekend's Gospel, those opposed to Jesus were trying to trap Him with a question related to taxation. Jesus responded by saying, "*repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.*" An image of Caesar and an inscription were on the Roman coinage. Therefore, they belonged to Caesar. Jesus does not ask, but the implied question then is: Where do we find God's image and inscription? The answer is, in us, His children. We are created by God in His image and God's law is inscribed on our hearts. Jesus' message to his opponents is that no matter what their allegiance was to Rome, they belonged to God. Caesar may claim the coins to be his own, but he cannot claim the people; the people are claimed by God ... the Creator.

We belong to God ... we are His, and we must repay to God what belongs to God. How do we do this? We do this by giving ourselves to God: loving Him with all our heart, all our soul, all our mind. We do this by giving God the best we have to offer: our first fruits of time, talent, and treasure. We do this by giving God our first allegiance: putting God first, before nations or kingdoms, political or economic systems, institutions, or ideologies.

May the Eucharist we receive each week unite us with Christ and each other, and strengthen our unity with our God, to whom we belong, now and forever.

Blessings on your week. Stay healthy and safe.

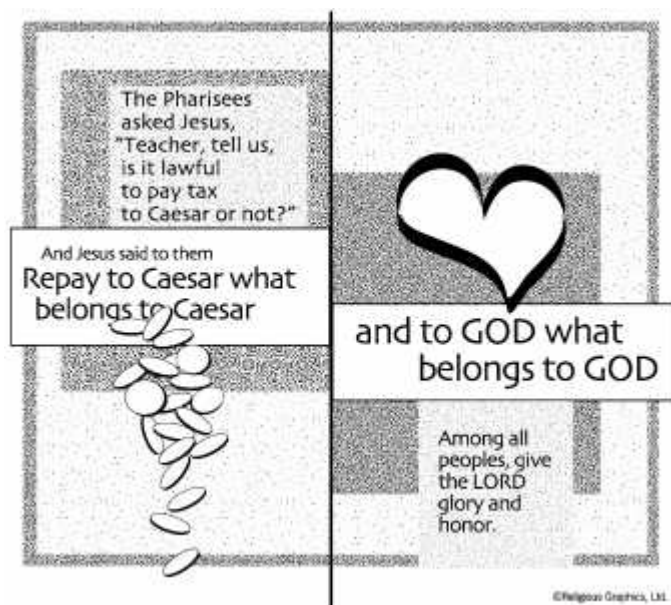

## RCIA - COME AND SEE ... COME AND LEARN

This week's Gospel story focuses on how Jesus escapes his opponents' deadly trap. It begins a series of controversies between Jesus and Pharisees who seek to "entrap" him through lose/lose questions. Should one pay the one denarius poll tax to the Roman government? It is not a political statement about paying taxes or promoting a separation between Church and state. It's really about where our first allegiance lies.

Jesus very cleverly tells his opponents "to repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." Only the official coin belongs to Caesar. However, Jewish creation theology taught that everything and *everyone* belonged to God, the Creator. Jesus denies Caesar any claim to divinity. That is reserved to God alone. But Caesar can have back his one coin, for it already belongs to him.

The new season of the **RCIA** (*Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*) is starting. Our meetings begin in the Fall, culminate at Easter, and are meant to provide a learning experience that will bring participants into full fellowship with the Catholic Church. (*We also take time to break open the scriptures such as the one above!*)
