The month of October is known as the month of the Holy Rosary primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7. It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church. With this being said, many outside of the Church ask the question: Why do Catholics pray to Mary, especially through the devotion of the Holy Rosary? There are a number of reasons why we pray to Mary but for the sake of addressing those who may be curious, here is one answer we can provide to those who are inquiring.

All prayer has God as its object. When we "pray to Mary" we are really praying to God *through* Mary. We are asking Mary to intercede and present our petitions to God. Recall how Solomon promised not to refuse any request of Bathsheba, the Queen Mother (1 Kings 2). Nor will the King of kings refuse the petition of His Queen Mother, just as He did not refuse her request at the wedding feast of Cana (John 2). Mary's intercession is completely subordinate to, and dependent upon, Jesus' intercession. Read the whole passage (1 Timothy 2:1-8): St. Paul *commands* Christians to intercede for one another. This does not circumvent Christ's mediation, because Jesus is the one mediator between earth and heaven, we as members of Christ's body are able to cooperate with Him as mediators. We single out Mary's intercession because she is God's most righteous saint and "the prayer of the righteous has great power in its effects" (James 5:16).

For those of our friends and family who are especially fond of quoting scripture we might hear something like this: "Catholics repeat many prayers in the Rosary. In Matthew 6:7, Jesus condemns repetitious prayer." Jesus is not condemning *all* repeated prayer, just prayer repeated "as the Gentiles do; for they think they will be heard for their many words." 1 Kings 18:25-29 provides an example of this pagan mentality that mere repetition will force their god to respond. If *all* repetition is wrong, you could say the Our Father only once in your life. Jesus repeats the same prayer three times in the Garden of Gethsemane. The humble publican who repeated "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner" went home justified, while the proud Pharisee who prayed extemporaneously did not. The four living creatures in heaven repeat their prayer day and night (Rev. 4:8). Psalm 136 is a highly repetitious litany that is inspired by God! Prayer repeated with the proper disposition is very pleasing to God and that certainly includes the Rosary.

May we all take the time in the month of October to ask our Holy Mother Mary to protect us and console us. May we also take the time to renew our devotion to the Holy Rosary. Our lives are filled with various difficulties and challenges and Mary knows that, and she wants to help us. Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us.

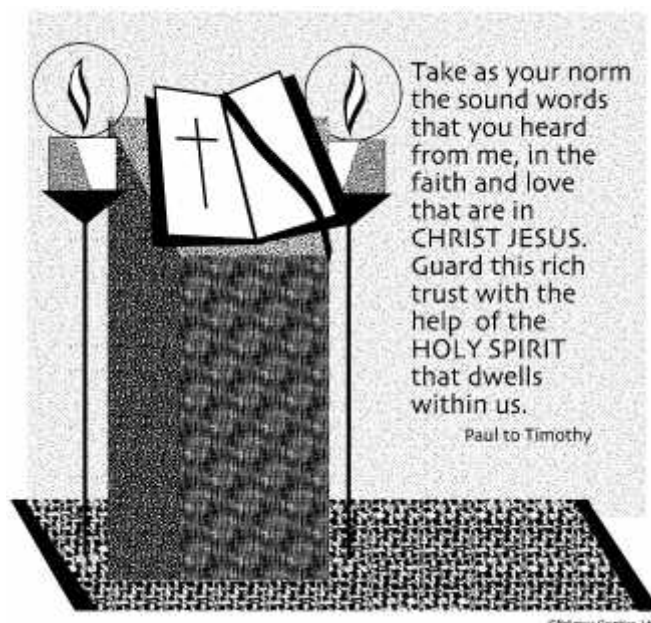
