In the first reading from the book of Zephaniah, God promises to preserve a remnant for Israel. However, one remarkable thing about this promise is that this group would be made up of only humble and lowly people. Through the church, God has invited us to form part of these humble people that put their confidence in Him. He invites us to be part of this remnant through honesty, humility, and obedience to God. We sometimes try to resist this rest to which God has invited us. This is because we often think we can get it only with money, fame, and power. Let us not deceive ourselves but continue to follow the values that radiate from the person and life of Jesus Christ.

The gospel of this weekend is from the sermon on the mountain. Christ recounts and reminds us of the most important Christian virtues that will help us become part of this remnant God promises to elect for himself in our first reading. If we meditate on this, we will see that the poor in spirit, that is, those who suffer, those who mourn, the hungry and thirsty for justice, those who work for peace, the merciful, the pure in heart, the insulted and persecuted are living a voluntarily life that draws them closer to God.

They are the living blessedness we see in the saints of all times. Saint Francis lived in poverty, Saint Ignatius in obedience, Saint Augustine preferred the love of God, Saint Thomas Aquinas embraced the wisdom of God, and Saint Theresa of Avila soaked herself in prayer. These and other saints are reflections of the same Christ. They are blessed. Today the church reminds us that we could also be part of them if we persevere. Today, they are the full members of the remnants of God's eternal kingdom. They pray and wait for us to join them. "How happy are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of God."

The parish has been very busy preparing for many joyful events coming up. Catholic Schools week, implementing the Eucharistic Revival, Ash Wednesday/Lent, March 17 – Day of Grace, Easter Season, Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation, just to name a few. Make sure you read the bulletin to keep up with everything happening. Let's make this coming season one filled with the grace and love of Jesus.

602 Beltrami Building Update

The proposed daycare facility will operate under a new type of license recently developed by the State of Minnesota. The license is like the license under which St. Philip's Catholic School runs its school program.

Larry Mack has agreed to manage the building project.

Recent/current activities include:

- ✓ A meeting with representatives from the City of Bemidji, Beltrami County, the Bemidji Fire Department, and staff took place to determine requirements for architectural drawings to be submitted for approval to various entities overseeing licensing, building occupancy, and fire safety.
- ✓ Planning for required sprinkler system installation.
- ✓ Removing items that will not be used in the building. Items will be made available to area non-profits for their use.
- ✓ Developing program structure (ages, numbers, nine-month, and 12-month), staffing profile, application process, and more.
- ✓ There are many variables involved, but the goal is to open Fall 2023.

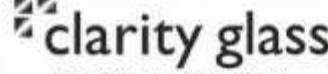
