From the Pastor

Two weeks ago, Bishop Cozzens was here for the Rite of Installation of a Pastor. In one part of the rite, the Pastoral Council comes forth and the bishop turned to me and said, *"Father, this is the pastoral council of St. Philip's parish. It is the voice of your people and will assist and counsel you as you minister to this parish. Always be attentive to the needs they express."* And I responded, *"My friends, I pledge to seek your counsel, guidance, and advice in the spiritual and temporal care of my pastorate."*

Our pastoral council has a monthly meeting during which a wide range of matters are discussed. It can be an efficient way for a pastor to hear what is going on in the parish, to learn about the concerns and joys of the community. This is especially true for a new pastor who has just started at a parish. It does not mean that the pastor needs to take action on everything, *or anything*, that is mentioned. The role of the council is advisory, but a wise pastor will appreciate consulting with the faithful to hear what he may not otherwise hear. In the past, I found that the pastor is often times the last to know what is really happening in some part of the parish. People don't want to bother Father. So, I will rely on the parish council for their counsel, guidance and advice. If you should *ever* receive a message from any of the St. Philip's priests, please look it over closely to see if it actually makes sense. If you have a trace of doubt, you can always call the parish to see if it is authentic. Scammers go on parish websites and use information about priests to make their scam message look legitimate. The faithful don't want to ignore what their priest is asking, so they sometimes follow through on peculiar messages that the scammer use to get them to give them money. NEVER buy gift cards for your priest, *or anyone else*, just because a text message says there is some urgent need. The steps they give you to follow ensure the money ends up in the scammer's pocket.

Schedule Updates

Our Baptism class is moving from Sunday mornings to the first Saturday morning to allow time to get to know parents and discuss the importance of Baptism.

We have added times for Adoration and Reconciliation on Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays. Also, Mass will be held the first Saturday of the month followed by Adoration and Reconciliation.
