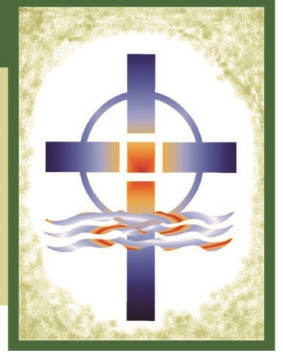

Happy Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time:

In our Gospel reading this weekend Jesus shares with his followers an important fact about temptation and leading another into it.

"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea."

Jesus also made it clear that whatever temptation comes your way and causes you to sin should be removed or avoided at all cost. Even if you have to pluck out your eye or cut off your foot. These are certainly very extreme measures, but avoiding temptation so as to be able to avoid sin is of utmost importance.

There are so many temptations in our society today. They come at us in many different ways. Television, the internet, social media, society, friends, relatives, classmates and co-workers. Many times, they seem innocent enough and well intentioned.

Why don't you come have a drink with me. You seem kind of down, try this pill. Have another donut, they are so good. I know he really likes you, find a way to be alone with him and let him kiss you. It's only a few dollars, no one will ever know.

If we have a problem with alcohol or drugs, or with eating the wrong things, or are tempted with sex, money or things. Whatever the temptation is and where ever it comes from, we need to learn how to resist it. The first thing is to recognize that we have a problem. Once we have done that, then we need to put it in God's hands and ask him for help. Pray about it, find ways to avoid the temptation and learn how to resist temptation when we are not able to avoid it. One way to do that is to surround ourselves with friends and family who will lead us in the right direction.

God wants us to avoid sin, but knows that we may not always succeed, so that is why he gave us the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We as Christian Catholics have the perfect remedy for when we do sin. Do as the Jesus taught us in the Lord's prayer. Allow him to forgive us as we forgive others!

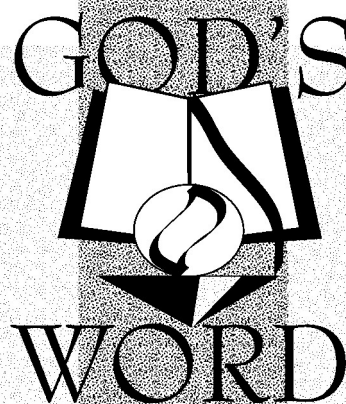
