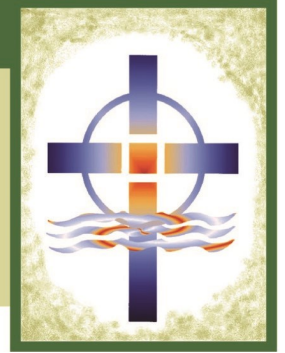

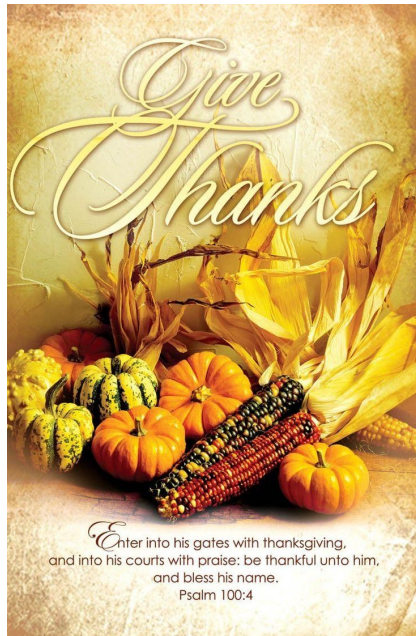

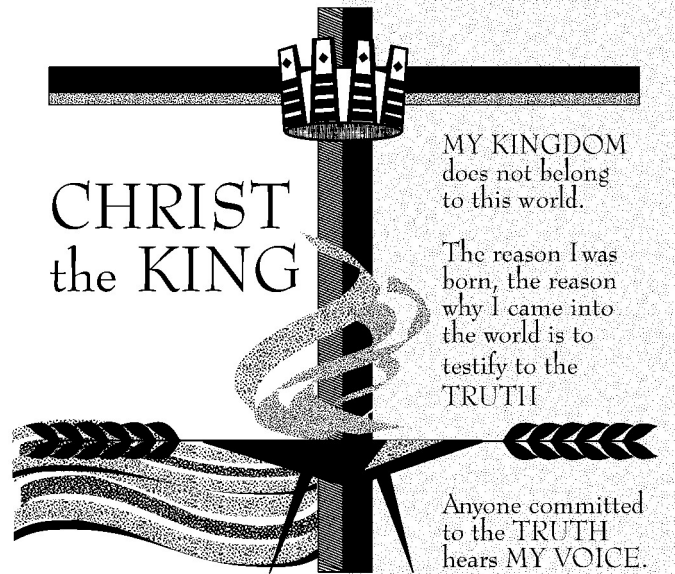

St. Philip's Church is filling, "Tubs of Christmas Love" during Advent. The food and gifts collected will be shared with local low-income families or those experiencing hardship.

- From Nov 30 to Dec 13th there will be red plastic "Christmas Tubs" in the social hall that will serve as Christmas Baskets.
- The lid on each tub will have a label identifying the number of family members, ages of the children and may have some other specific information.
- The tub can be filled with items appropriate for a holiday meal, and/or a gift certificate for perishable food including items such as turkey, pie, etc. A family game or small gift items could also be included.
- Simply take a tub, fill it, and return it to the bow window at the back of the church (on weekends) or to the parish office (during the week). Keep the label attached to the lid.

- Feel free to partner with another family or your work place to fill one!

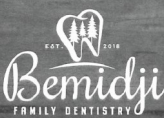
