BLESSING OF EASTER BASKETS ON HOLY SATURDAY

In many Eastern European countries, it is a tradition to prepare a basket of food to be blessed on Holy Saturday. In Poland, the blessing of the baskets is a tradition dating back to the 15th century, and is still observed to this day. The basket is lined with a beautiful embroidered cloth and covered with a white linen cloth, representing the shroud of Christ. A typical basket would include: bacon: a symbol of God's abundant mercy; Easter bread, or babka: a symbol of the Risen Lord who gives us Himself in the Eucharist; butter: normally in the shape of a lamb, symbolic of Jesus, the Lamb of God; cheese: a reminder of the Christian virtue of moderation; colored eggs: a symbol of the hope and new life Christ gives us in His rising from the tomb; ham: to celebrate the end of Lent when we fasted from meat; sausage, or kielbasa: the sausage links are symbolic of the chains of death that were broken when Jesus rose from the dead; horseradish: a reminder of the bitterness of Jesus' Passion; salt: which ads zest to life and preserves us from corruption; sweets: symbolizing the promise of Eternal Life; and lastly, a candle is placed in the basket and lit prior to the Blessing, the candle symbolizes Jesus, the Light of the World. We all have special foods for special times of the year. You are welcome to bring your Easter breads, colored eggs, candy, Easter pies, etc. to be blessed on Holy Saturday morning at 11:00am in the Church. Let us give thanks to God for His gift of life and love, which we share with our loved ones around the table of His Altar and the table of our homes.
