A Letter from the Cardinal

Dear friends in the Lord:

When we are told that the Lord calls each of us to be co-missionaries and co-evangelizers of the Church, as was St. Paul and the other apostles, we do not often realize how much mission work there is to be done in the United States. There is far more than you or I could ever imagine.

The annual National Black and Indian Mission

Collection, taken up in parishes across the nation today enables the Church in the United States to provide desperately required pastoral, educational and spiritual assistance to some of the needlest of our brothers and sisters in the Lord. From the inner cities of the rural south to the deserts of the southwest to the wilderness of Alaska, grants from the annual appeal make it possible for the Church to assist our Black and Indian Catholic communities. Here in the archdiocese, we receive grants twice a year that are applied to Black parishes in Harlem and the Bronx, making it possible for them to serve their parishioners much more than they could on their own.

With this letter, I invite you to be as generous as you possibly can be in making a sacrificial offering to this crucially important and necessary ministry of the Church.
