## **Restoration Work in the Church to Begin!**

Thank you all for making our Capital Campaign, Renew + Rebuild, such a success. To date, you have pledged \$850,000, with pledges still coming in. Now begins the work promised and hoped for!

With proper permissions from the Archdiocese and approval of our own Parish Finance Committee and our Parish Trustees, we have borrowed \$600,000 from the Bank of Millbrook to begin the restoration work in our Church. This amount will be paid back to the Bank as your pledge money is received.

We are beginning the work in the Church now because it is our hope that it will be completed in time for Holy Week, Easter and the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Also, we have Weddings scheduled in the Spring, the first one being at the end of April. Any other time of the year would interfere with scheduled events such as Weddings.

During the time of renovation, daily and Sunday Masses will be held in the Parish Hall. All meetings regularly scheduled in the Hall will be moved to another site. Our weekly Confirmation classes on Monday evenings will meet in the school building for the remainder of the year.

Funeral Masses will of course be of concern for us during the time of restoration. A funeral Mass with the presence of Cremains will be held in the Parish Hall. Because we are not able to fit a full size casket through the doors of the Hall, Funeral Masses with the presence of the body will be scheduled at St. Stanislaus Church in Pleasant Valley with Msgr. Colacicco as celebrant. We are most grateful to Father Bakus of St. Stanislaus for graciously accommodating us during this time.

The pews will be removed from the Church on Monday, January 9th, and scaffolding will be raised soon after that. The Church will be closed beginning that Monday and all Masses will be offered in the Parish Hall beginning on that day. For your safety, we ask that no one enter the Church while work is being done.

This is a very exciting time for our Parish. Please pray that everything goes well with the work and no unexpected hurdles present themselves in the process. I will keep you updated on the progress of the work. Thank you for your generous donations which make this possible.


