

The 100th Anniversary of Our Lady’s Apparition in Fatima

During the First World War (1917), the Blessed Virgin appeared to three shepherd children near Fatima, in Portugal: Lucia dos Santos, age 10 and her cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, ages 8 and 7. Her six visits began on May 13 and ended in October, the month of the Rosary. Our Lady requested the daily recitation of the Rosary, penance and devotion to Her Immaculate Heart. During the following weeks we will publish Our Lady’s messages to the children, as well as the prayers given them to recite.


