The 100th Anniversary of Our Lady's Apparition in Fatima

"The moment has come in which God asks the Holy Father, in union with all the Bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. There are so many souls whom the Justice of God condemns for sins committed against me, that I have come to ask reparation: sacrifice yourself for these intentions and pray!"

(Our Lady, June 13, 1917)

According to Sr. Lucia, Pope St. John Paul II consecrated Russia to Mary's Immaculate Heart on March 25, 1984. The USSR fell shortly afterwards.

Afternoon Tea to Honor the Widows of Our Parish

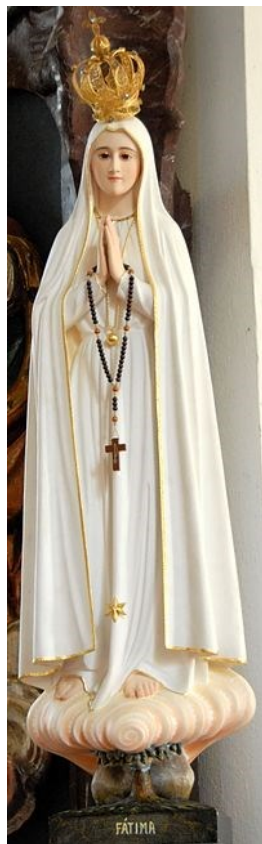
An Afternoon Tea will be held to honor the widows of St. Joseph-Immaculate Conception Parish. This event is by invitation only to the widows of the Parish.

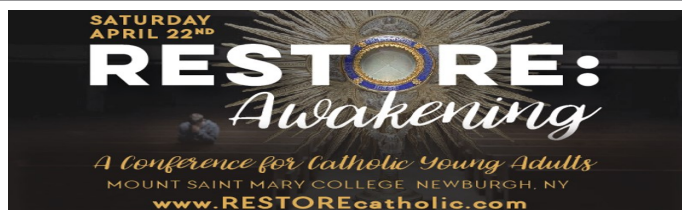
