FRIENDS OF SENIORS SEEKING VOLUNTEERS!!

Friends of Seniors, established in 2004, is an independent nonprofit (501c3) that provides basic support services to the Dutchess County older adult community by arranging transportation to non-emergency medical appointments. We also provide grocery shopping for those who have no relatives living in the area and no alternative means to get food. We also provide visiting services; respite for primary caregivers, and telephone reassurance. All services are provided by volunteers who drive their own cars. All services are **FREE**.

Last year, Friends of Seniors volunteers drove a remarkable 97,110 miles to medical appointments and provided 1,500 hours of grocery shopping, visiting, etc. assisting 334 individuals. Many of those individuals used our services multiple times.

As the senior population grows, the requests for services also increase. We now find ourselves in a position where the requests are beyond what our present volunteer base can handle, and we are looking for more volunteers for all services. We pay mileage reimbursement at 30 cents a mile and have an umbrella insurance policy. This is a no-pressure volunteer job. Your time is your own.
