The Franciscan Friars of the Renewal will be with us to preach our Lenten Parish Mission. Fr. Giuseppe Siniscalchi, CFR will preach at all of our weekend Masses March 23-24. Each evening of the Mission will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and conclude with Benediction. Brothers of the Order will be present to provide the music. Monday evening's topic is "The loving presence of Jesus in your life." Tuesday evening's topic is "The life-changing mercy of God." Confessions will be available after the meditation. We will not have Benediction; the evening will conclude when the confessions are done. Wednesday evening's topic is "The healing power of Jesus." The meditation will be followed by a Eucharistic healing procession in the Church.

NOTE: Mass on Wednesday will be offered at 7:30am (no 5pm Mass) and there will be a free will offering for the Franciscan Friars at the end of the Mission. Checks can be made out to the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal. Please plan on joining us and bring a friend.
