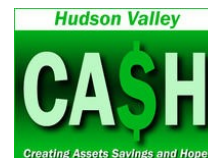
The next meeting of the Millbrook Council of the Knights of Columbus will be held on **TUESDAY, November 2nd**, at 7:00pm in the Parish Hall.
