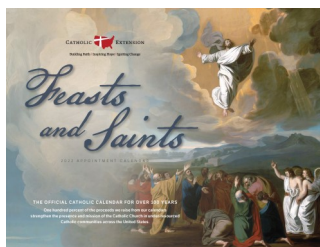
Altar Flowers
