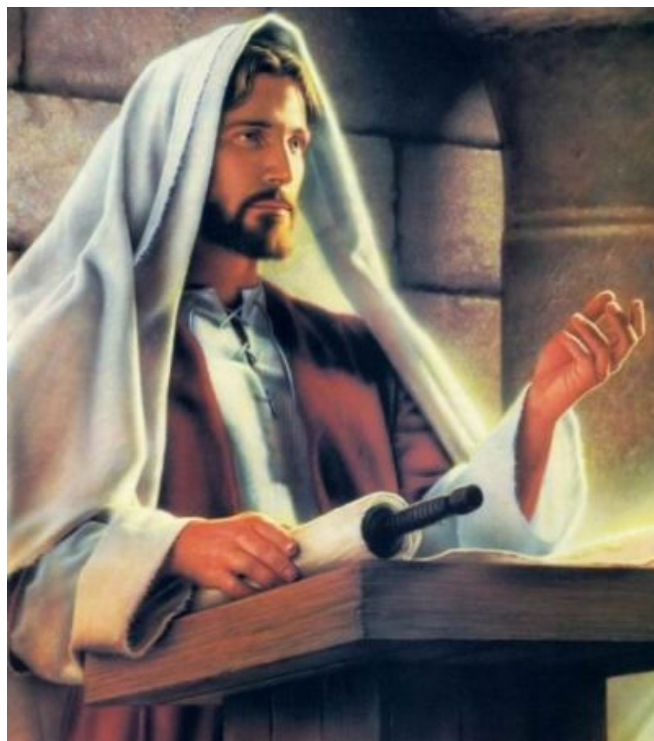

To apply:

- 1) Applicant needs to be one of the following — a graduating HS Senior and a child or grandchild of a member of our Council, **OR** a child of a member of St. Joseph-Immaculate Conception Parish, **OR** a graduating senior of Millbrook High School, Millbrook, NY
- 2) Applicant must be going on to a school of further learning — either a College, University or Trade School
- 3) Applicant must submit a letter stating why he or she should be considered and awarded one of the above awards. This letter must include the school they attend, their academic standing, and activities they participated in (in school and out of school) such as clubs, sports, music, theater, charities, religious activities, etc.
- 4) Letter of application must be received by April 15 to be considered. Time and place of award will be determined by where winners are located.
