May Crowning

On Mother's Day weekend, we remember both our mothers who took care of us on earth, and our Heavenly Mother Mary, given to us by Jesus. "Behold your mother." (Jn. 19:27) At each of our Masses this weekend, a First Communicant will be crowning a Marian statue. Jesus first took on flesh by Mary's "yes", so these children give thanks to Mary for making it possible to receive Communion.

Here are the four statues we will be crowning:

- 1. Our Lady of Guadalupe: in the front left of our church, this is a reminder of when Mary appeared on American shores, "clothed in the sun."
- 2. the wooden statue: from the renovation of our church in the 1940's, Mary carrying Jesus
- 3. Our Lady of Lourdes: originally from Immaculate Conception Church, this reminds us of when Mary appeared to St. Bernadette and identified herself with. "I am the Immaculate Conception"
- 4. the outside statue: Mary, full of grace, looking over our village as a reminder that she is praying for us

Mother's Day Cards


