
Ash Wednesday is Valentine's Day

This year Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day fall on the same day, February 14. Ash Wednesday begins the Church season of Lent, a time of preparation for the great feast of Easter. Ash Wednesday, therefore, is a day of fast and abstinence for Catholics. This year you may want to consider joyfully celebrating Valentine's Day a few days early so that you may fully enter into this holy time of preparation.

Mass Etiquette

- **1. FAST:** Do not eat any food an hour before Mass.
- **2. COME EARLY:** Allow 10-15 minutes of meditation before the Mass.
- 3. DO NOT EAT OR CHEW GUM
- **4. DRESS PROPERLY:** This is to show decency and honor to God.
- 5. NO PHONES: Turn your cell phones off.
- **6. GENUFLECT:** Kneel your right knee in the direction of the Tabernacle before sitting.
- **7. PARTICIPATE:** Sing, respond, listen, and pray.
- 8. COMMUNE: Examine conscience beforehand.
- **9. THINK OF OTHERS:** Respect the pew and the queue.
- 10. ENJOY THE MOMENT: Don't be in a hurry. Enjoy and feel

God's presence and thank Him for His graces.
