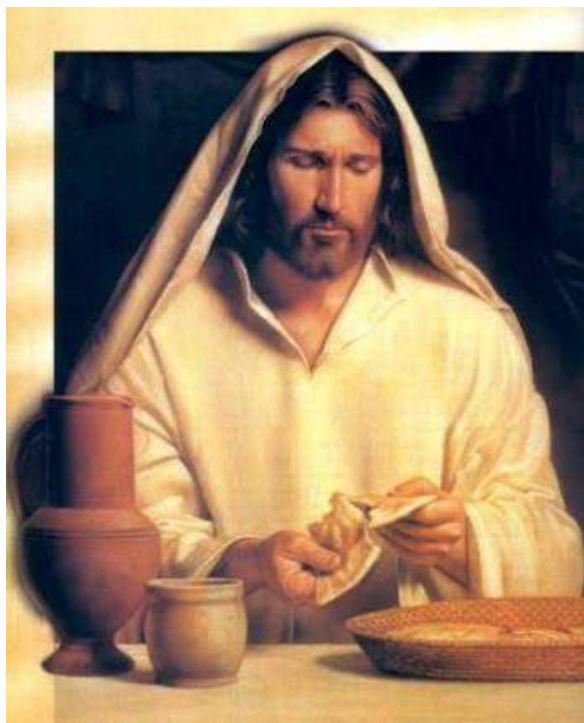

Grateful to you for your past generosity of \$266,052, I write today to ask for your solicitude again as we prepare to collect an offering on **Sunday, August 11**, for the *Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa*. Founded on the basic principles of Pope St. John Paul II's call to action, the fund has been making real differences in the lives of Catholics for almost 20 years through its support of seminary training, the formation of religious sisters and brothers, health care and hunger relief, and other pastoral ministries that address the needs of the rapidly growing African Church.

Africa faces the economic and social hurdles of enormous debt, epidemic, severe poverty, persecution, and political unrest. Despite these challenges, the Church in Africa has almost tripled in size in the past thirty years.
