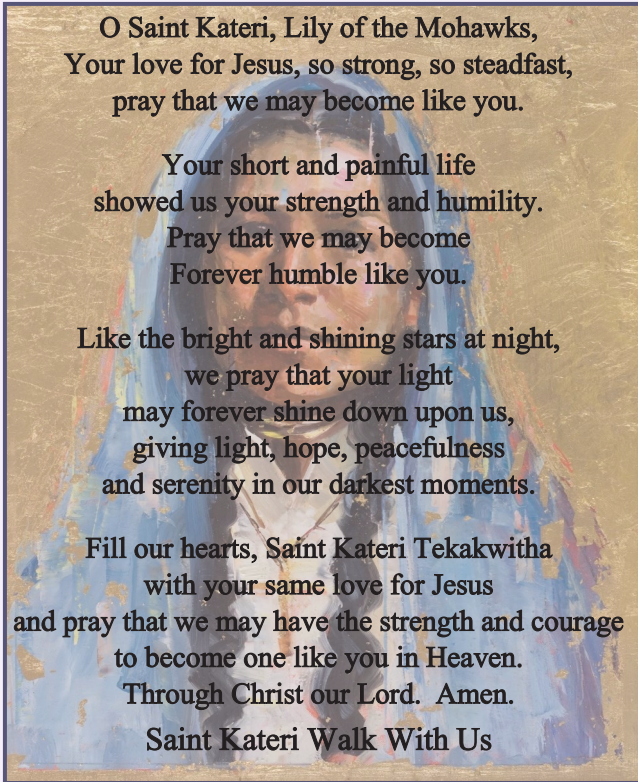

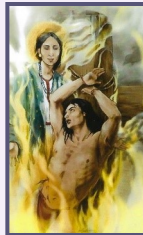

- ⇒ Number of applicants who visited the National Conference Center 2

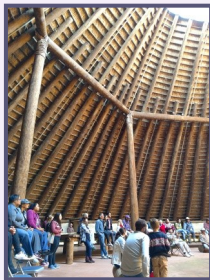
