



CONFIRMATION DRESS GUIDELINES

At the celebration of the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion, special gowns and clothing are worn to reflect the importance of these sacred events. It is fitting to dress in celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation as well. Semi-formal, modest attire is appropriate to the solemn beauty of the Confirmation Mass. Modesty is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. “Teaching modesty to children and adolescents means awakening in them respect for the human person.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church #2524)

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| Young Women | Teen Girls should wear a modest dress or skirt that is NO shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee (longer is fine). If the dress or top is sleeveless, a sweater should always be worn while in the church. Low-cut tops are inappropriate for the Mass. |
| Young Men | Teen Boys should wear a suit, or slacks with a button-down shirt, tie, and jacket. Dress shoes and dress belt should be worn. |
| Jeans, sneakers, flip flops, sweats, and see-through material are inappropriate for the Mass and should not be worn. | |
