**Palm Sunday**

**Holy Day of Obligation**

Today, Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified.


Today we reenact Christ's arrival into Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes or possibly palms in front of him as a sign of homage.

The branches are a widely recognized symbol of peace and victory and the donkey is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war.

**A week later**, Christ would rise from the dead on the first Easter.

**Good Friday Fasting**

For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on **fasting** are obligatory from **age 18 until age 59**. When fasting, a person is permitted to **eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.**


