The Sacraments



Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (*vitae spiritualis ianua*), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission: "Baptism is the sacrament of regeneration through water and in the word."

Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 1213

"O man, why do you think so little of yourself when God thinks so highly of you? Why dishonor yourself when God so honors you? Why be so concerned with the stuff from which you are made and so little with the purpose for which you are made? All visible creation is your home. For you the light dispels the darkness; for you the sun, moon, and stars shed their light; for you the earth bears flowers and trees and fruits; for you the air and the earth and water are filled with marvelous life - all so that earthly life may not be sad and make you blind to the joy of eternity."

St. Peter Chrysologus was named "Doctor of the Church" in 1729. His feast day is July 30.



ASPERGES (From aspergere - to sprinkle) The rite of sprinkling and blessing the faithful with holy water.



Saint John Vianney - Feast Day August 4th



The Cure' of Ars, is the beloved patron of parish priest. Born in France (1786), he was a“delayed vocation” who with great difficulty got through the seminary. He transformed the godless parish of Ars by holiness, preaching, prayers and penances. Ars became a place of pilgrimage because of its holy pastor. He would hear confessions for 16 hours a day. St. John Vianney died in 1859 and was canonized a saint in 1925.


