

ST. PIUS X - FEAST DAY AUGUST 21st



Born near Venice in 1835, Giuseppe Sarto became successively priest, bishop of Mantua, Patriarch of Venice, and, in 1903, Pope. Humble and strong, he carried these increasingly heavy responsibilities with simplicity, piety and balance. He authorized First Holy Communion at the age of reason and strongly defended the Church against Modernism. Pius X died as World War I started, in 1914, and was canonized a saint in 1954.
