

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY FEAST DAY - OCTOBER 7TH



On October 7, the Roman Catholic Church celebrates the yearly feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against

Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was involved on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe.

This memorial however is not of a past event. It reminds us of meditation on the mysteries of Christ with the help of Mary. Such meditation is coveted with the incarnation, sufferings and glorious Resurrection of the Son of God.


