Ways to Celebrate May, the Month of Mary

You can choose various forms: Kolbe, or St. Louis de Montfort, or the modern one done by Fr. Michael Gaitely - *33 Days to Morning Glory*. This consecration could change dramatically your whole life.

The Church will be locked at all times except during Masses. We have installed a punch button lock box. For access code, please call the rectory.


